




Reception Newsletter – Spring 1

Ways to help your child's understanding of the world:

- Talk and describe what you can see in our world whilst out and about – focus on natural things like animals and plants.
- Talk about the key differences between hot and cold countries, including the weather and what animals live there.
- Talk about how a baby cow is called a calf, a baby sheep is a lamb, a baby horse is a foal etc..
- Show your child how they can use their 5 senses to explore our wonderful world (sight, taste, smell, touch and hearing)

Developing Memory

Helping to develop your child's memory skills is a great way of supporting their learning.

Memory games generally work by improving **working memory**. This is the information you can hold in your brain that you are able to access straight away.

Having a strong working memory means you can retain information and apply it.

Children with strong working memories can focus on activities and retain information with accuracy.

Games to play at home:

Pairs games (find the 2 matching pictures using cards)
Kim's games (hide objects under a cloth, remove one – can your child remember which is missing?)
